The EFBWW condemns the recent decisions of the Italian government, regarding the elimination of the limit on subcontracting and the reduction of investment in bonuses for renovation. We want to show our solidarity with you and our support for the actions you decide to take to oppose these resolutions.


These measures go against everything we have been defending, favouring labour exploitation of workers, especially the most vulnerable such as migrant and posted workers, and encouraging the emergence of fraudulent companies and crime.

This is indeed a worrying step backwards on the road towards a fairer, more secure labour market with direct jobs. The Renovation Wave and EU Green Deal must be an opportunity for workers not an opportunity for labour abuse.

The EFBWW has launched a campaign on [subcontracting](#) to demand new legislation to stop exploitation in subcontracting chains. We need to limit subcontracting and promote direct, quality jobs. On the 7 of June, we will take our demands to the streets and organise a demonstration in front of the European institutions in Brussels. We take this opportunity to invite you to join us on this day.
